What? Participants may send in a **pre-recorded video (up to one minute)** of themselves performing a talent such as singing, martial arts, dancing, sports-related skill, magic trick, monologue, juggling, poem reading, instrumental performances, etc. or they may send in a **picture** of a visual arts talent such as drawing, painting, sculpture, jewelry-making, knitting, sewing projects, original LEGO creations, etc.

How?

You may also include information like how long you've been working on this talent, where did you learn this talent, or any other information that you think would be fun/useful to share.
