Performance Guidelines

- Acts must be 3 minutes or less and appropriate for an elementary age audience.
- Acts using songs with lyrics must submit a copy of the lyrics with the application.
- Vocal performances accompanied by music should be without lead vocal tracks. Lip-syncing is not allowed.
- The Talent Show committee will reject performances not meeting these criteria.
- The Talent Show is open to McKenny students only, preschool through 5th grades.
- Students may participate in ONE ACT ONLY.

Participant Expectations

- Performers must attend both rehearsals and are expected to stay for the duration of the show on March 4th.
- All accompaniment music must be on CD with the performer's name and song number.
- Requests to perform at a specific time will not be granted although placement in the line-up is flexible if special accommodation is required.
- Performers should attend dress rehearsal in full dress; photographs will be taken.
- Performers must arrive by 6:00 pm the night of the show.

Talent Show Details

- Date: Thursday, March 4, 2010
- Time: Doors open at 6:00 pm, Talent Show begins at 6:30 pm.
- Tickets will be available at the door. Admission is \$1 plus a non-perishable food item per person.
- Seating is available first-come, first-served. Saving seats will not be allowed prior to doors opening.
- Photography and recording of the performance is allowed.
- Flowers and concessions will be available for purchase the night of the performance. Cash only please.
